MESSAGE from the President



Bringing in 2019 means Spring activities will soon be here. I hope you will help spread the word about the Tulsa Area Alumnae Panhellenic Spring Recruitment Information Session. You can find information about the event in this newsletter. As an alumnae, I hope you will remember all the great times you had in college with your sisters and help high school seniors learn what to expect and how to prepare for recruitment by spreading the word about this great event. On April 5th we will be celebrating all

the women being honored by their chapters as Woman of the Year. I hope I will see many of you at Tulsa Country Club for this beautiful luncheon!

I want to inform you about a new Governance Structure Change that National Panhellenic Conference approved in October 2018 at the annual meeting. Effective July 1, 2019, NPC will transition to a seven-member Board of Directors and a 25-member Council of Delegates. The Chairmanship of NPC will no longer rotate through NPC member organizations. The Council of Delegates will elect the chairman from the seven board members. This decision is in response to the challenges facing students today which require engagement from professionals that serve panhellenic and will help NPC take a more strategic approach.

I am sure you have heard from your chapters about the #StandUpToHarvard petition. In short, last Fall (2018) Harvard University began to enforce the 2016 policy imposing sanctions against students who belong to single sex organizations. This includes sororities and fraternities. The policy takes away the opportunity for those belonging to these organizations to hold leadership roles in other Harvard organizations. It also affected their ability to obtain post-graduate fellowships and scholarships influenced or controlled by the university. In December several sororities, fraternities and students filed federal and state lawsuits challenging the policy. Thank you to all of you who purchased poinsettias to help support Tulsa Area Alumnae Panhellenic. I also want to thank all the delegates for their hard work and dedication to make sure each TAAP event runs smoothly and successfully.
