### TAAP Receives NPC Programming Award

The National Panhellenic Conference (NPC), one of the nation's largest advocacy organizations for women, recently recognized top Alumnae Panhellenic groups for service to community and sorority.

The Tulsa Area Alumnae Panhellenic was recognized with a Programming Excellence Award for the overall variety and quality of experience and service provided to the women and community of Tulsa.

According to NPC's most current data, there are 197 Alumnae Panhellenics. In the past year, community-based alumnae groups have collectively:

- Donated 53,394 hours to community service;
- Raised \$438,757 for undergraduate scholarships;
- Awarded 412 scholarships;
- And contributed \$84,247 to community causes.

"We're recognizing alumnae organizations for continuing excellence and service they provide in their communities and to sorority women in college," said Nicki Meneley, executive director of the conference.


