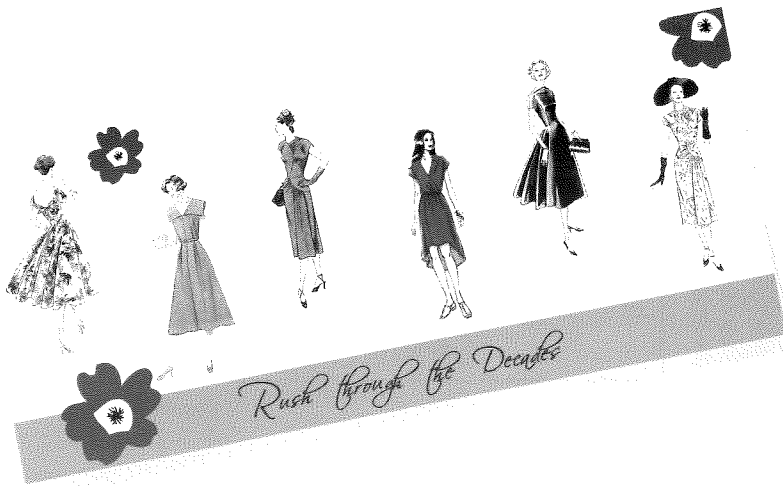

 1. The chance to honor some amazing Tulsa women.


